In recent years it has been reported that plastic waste in the sea is a growing problem. Some of this waste is resin pellets that entered the waste stream and the oceans as a result of spill during production, shipping/unshipping and transport.

Plastix is aware of this problem and takes its share of responsibility. Being a clean-tech company, which provides sustainable solutions for cleaner environments and oceans, it is in Plastix's spirit to be a part of the solution to the problem - not a part of the problem. Therefore Plastix is developing a waste management system with a focus on proper containment of the products we handle - plastic pellets, as well as our raw materials – plastic fibers. By preventing the pellets/fibers from getting into waterways that eventually lead to the sea, Plastix contributes to preserving water quality and wildlife.

As a part of this policy Plastix has committed itself to the Operation Clean Sweep (OCS), which is an international concept developed by the American industry associations Society of the Plastics Industry and the American Chemistry Council. The OCS' goal is to help keeping plastic pellets out of the natural environment with the ultimate goal "zero pellet loss". Several hundred plastic companies around the world are already Operation Clean Sweep partners. Plastix is proud to be one of them and go forward in efforts to reduce contaminations from plastic pellets spill into our environment.
